


SOME OF MY Best Shots



Naval Radio Station (Transmitter) Jim Creek, outside of Arlington, Washington is one of those areas that seem to turn up the color volume in the fall. The Station consists of approximately 5,000 acres of mostly forested wildlife habitat, 250 of which are old growth forest. The Jim Creek wilderness area is designated for recreational use for Department of Defense personnel and has a lodge, cabins, recreational vehicle hookups, and camping areas.
